12 MONTHS

- * Choose a date
- * Talk budget

- * Create wedding style mood board on pinterest
- * Begin researching wedding dresses and veil styles

11-10 MONTHS

- * Interview wedding planners and hire one (Optional)
- * Reserve ceremony & reception venues
- * Purchase wedding dress, veil, undergarments
- * Select members of your wedding party
- * Book Photographer
- * Engagemnet Session

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9-8 MONTHS

- * Book officiant
- * Reserve a block of hotel rooms for out-of-town guests
- * Send Save The Dates
- * Refine guest list
- * Create gift registry
- * Hire vacation planner for honeymoon
- * Review quick wedding timeline with your photographer

5-4 MONTHS

- * Order wedding cake
- * Meet with florist
- * Schedule dress fittings
- * Book room for wedding night
- * Order rehearsal dinner invitations
- * Prepare a playlist for DJ/Band
- * Finalize guest list
- * Compile rehearsal dinner guest list



7-6 MONTHS

- * Reserve rentals
- * Book transportation to and from venues
- * Research wedding day hair and makeup styles
- * Meet with officiant to discuss run down of ceremony
- * Choose cake style & schedule tastings
- * Hire ceremony musicians
- * Decide and order wedding party attire
- * Personalize & order wedding invitation sample
- * Purchase wedding band
- * order wedding invitation suite
- * Order thank you cards
- * Finalize honeymoon plans with vacation planner and ensure all documents are in order

3 MONTHS

- * Finalize readers & readings
- * Plan reception seating
- * Purchase toasting flutes, serving pieces, guestbook, flower basket and ring bearer pillow
- * Finalize reception menu with caterer
- * Order menu cards
- * Mail wedding invitations

2 MONTHS

- * Final dress fitting +bridal session
- * Hair & makeup trial
- * Begin writing vows
- * Review ceremony details with officiant
- * Finalize seating arrangements
- * Buy Wedding-Party/parents gifts
- * Apply for marriage license
- * Purchase gifts for guests
- * Lay out the content for wedding programs
- * Finalize fittings for wedding party and parents
- * Create wedding day timelines and send to vendors, officiant and wedding party
- * Decide on "something old, something new, something borrowed and something blue"
- * Book spa and beauty treatments for you and bridal party

1 WEEK

- * Prepare wedding day emergency kit
- * Give readers their scripts
- * Prepare final payments to vendors and cash tip envelopes ready
- * Lay out wedding clothes & gather all accessories
- * Purchase a steamer (If venue does not provide one)
- * Full body wax (optional)

1 MONTHS

- * Pick up marriage license
- * Call vendors to confirm date, time and location
- * Confirm honeymoon reservations
- * Pick up wedding rings
- * Order wedding programs
- * Write thank you notes as gifts are received
- * Order bridal photo and engagemnt Prints

2 WEEKS

- * Begin breaking in wedding shoes
- * Make arrangements for the caring of pets & plants while on honeymoon
- * Follow up with guests who have not RSVP'd
- * Give final guest count to caterer
- * Send playlists to DJ/Band/musiciants
- * Get haircut & freshen up color
- * Update registries
- * Send directions to wedding day transportation driver
- * Delegate someone to return tuxes, rentals & tend to wedding dress



DAY BEFORE

- * Treat yourself to mani/pedi and massage
- * Get your eyebrows done
- * Wax/Shave/Treat your full face/neck (optional)
- * Attend wedding rehearsal
- * HAVE FUN!!
- * Get to bed early

AFTER THE WEDDING

- * Ensure tuxes & all rentals have been returned
- * Get wedding dress to cleaners
- * Send out thank you cards no later than 3 weeks after wedding day
- * Talk to your photographer about printing photos and/or albums

WEDDING IN 6 MONTHS OR LESS?

For those of you that have a shorter engagement period, especially 6 months or less, condense and divide all the months before the 3 months mark.

- * Give officiant fee & wedding ring to best man
- * Exchange notes with fiance
- * Relax, Smile & soak up every moment of the big day!
